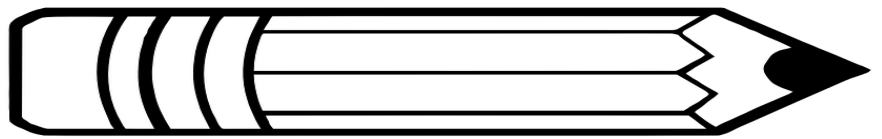

WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

Reading: Students will start to look at Poetry and then come back to more fiction texts as we start to partner read and then build Book Clubs.

Writing: Students will conclude their unit on opinion writing and transition to exploring various poetic forms, allowing them to express their thoughts and emotions.

Phonics: Students will work on open, closed, and r-controlled syllables and double vowel syllables to improve their phonetic and decoding skills.

Math: Students will be building arrays and equal groups and then start a graphing and measurement unit.

Science: Students will understand the life cycle of plants and animals as well as what they need to survive.

Social Studies: This month students will be learning about Women's History Month and taking a look at the women around them who impact their life.

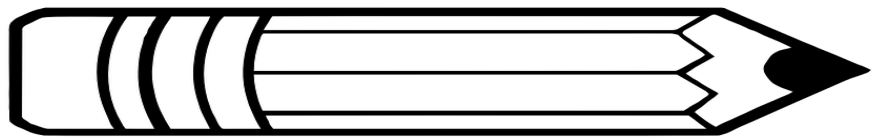
