Hello Room 213 Families,

We are off to a great start in 213 this year. I am thrilled to be working with each of you and your amazing kids.

This month, we will continue to work on establishing classroom routines with our Unit Theme: I Can Follow the Rules. Our units are based on the [Unique Learning System](#) curriculum.

In reading, we will introduce and practice the following high frequency words: at, can, why, your, we, his, to, walk, that, school, does, and hand. Students will work on answering basic wh questions and recognizing the beginning, middle, and end of stories. Our students who are able to read independently will work on expanding their vocabulary and reading leveled readers, while our students who are still practicing letter names and sounds will have targeted opportunities to practice those skills.

In math, students will begin working on recognizing coins and their values. We will continue to have calendar math time as part of the morning meeting. Additionally, we will learn about place value through our daily “days of school” count. During work time, students will work on their IEP specific goals related to number recognition, counting, or math functions.

In Science, we will be talking about germs and proper hand washing, while in Social Studies, we will learn about rules in different settings.
