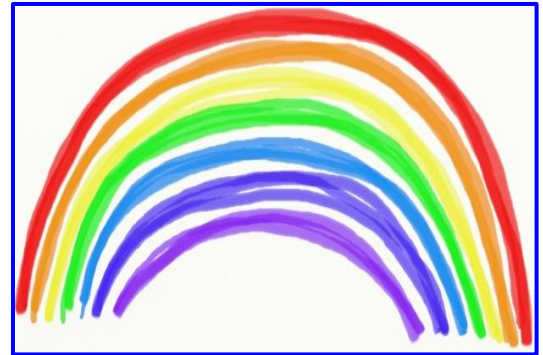

Curriculum Notes

Reading: We are now entering Module 4 of Readers Workshop. This unit focuses on comprehension and expressive reading.

Writing: We will begin a new writing unit; students will learn to write persuasive pieces to express their opinions and make their community and world a better place.

Math: We continue to work on story problems which include subtraction, addition, and decomposition.

Science: Students are learning about living things and what they need to survive. There will be focus will be on classifying animals (reptiles, mammals, etc).

Music: In April, students will continue to sing, play circle games, and prepare for our May concert! More details on the show will be sent home soon.

Physical Education: In April we will be beginning our gymnastics unit. Students will learn skills such as balancing, rolling, and jumping.
