Curriculum Notes

Phonics : Students are reading emergent books to reinforce familiar sight words and use picture cues to read words. Also, students are decoding short vowel words (mat, fix, not, etc.) and continue to build sight word knowledge. Some students are working on letter names and sounds.

Reading: Students will shift from learning about zoology to ecology. Students will continue to learn about habitats and life cycles. etc.

Writing: As writers, we continue to work on strengthening our illustrations, labels, and concepts of print through writing sentences, based on the reading units of study.

Math: Students are learning about measuring- length, width, volume, and capacity. Also students are counting 1 to 50 & recognizing numbers 0-20.
