

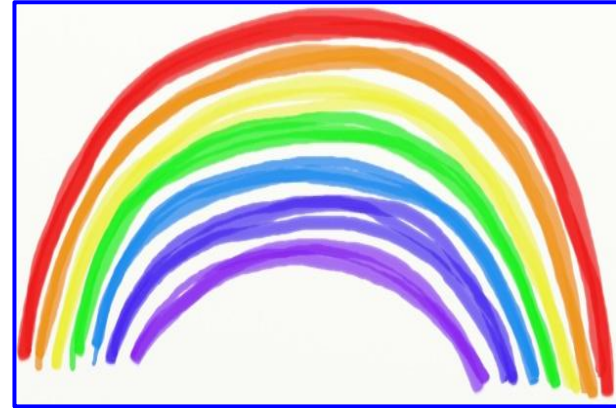

Curriculum Notes

Reading: Classes are concluding their unit on ecosystems. Our next unit of study is entomology- the study of bugs.

Writing: We will continue to write about facts about ecosystems, in addition to bugs and their life cycles. There will be a focus on using content vocabulary in the students' writing.

Math: Classes now shift their focus to subtraction, as well as continuing to work on story problems which include subtraction, addition, and decomposition.

Science: We start our new unit on plants, identifying plant needs & their life cycle.
