

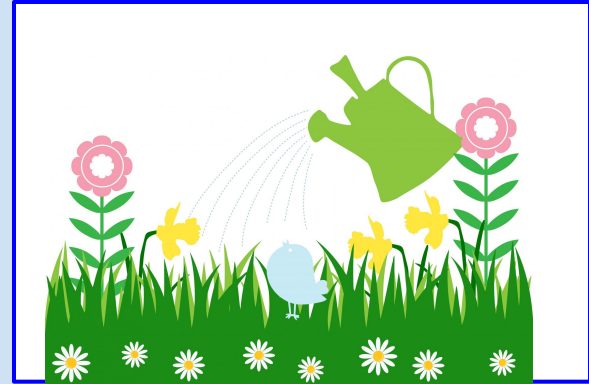

### Kindergarten Content

**Reading:** We will continue Unit 4, the study of entomology (bugs) and students will review what we've learned this year about animal and insect habitats, behaviors, and life cycles.

**Writing:** Students continue to draw, label their pictures, and write one or more sentences. We are also focusing on the revision process.

**Math:** Students will solidify verbal counting to 100, counting by tens and understanding base ten blocks in math, as well as reviewing 3D shapes and their attributes.
