

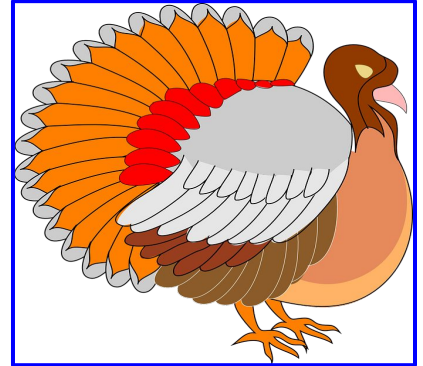

The schoolwide theme for November is gratitude. Students are reflecting on the things that make them thankful. Ask your child what they are thankful for today!

Kindergarten Content

Reading - We will continue to focus on letter identification, letter sounds, sight words, and the blending of short vowel (cvc) words. Letters include: v, w, y, x, z, q, while handwriting addresses forming uppercase letters.

This month and next, our reading/writing curriculum focuses on the study of Zoology, with students learning about mammals, birds, reptiles, fish and amphibians. Students will learn about their habitats, food, life cycles. etc.

Writing - Students continue to strengthen their skills in illustrating, labeling (spelling objects) and being exposed to sentence structure.

Math - We will be working with verbal counting, number identification 11-20, shapes and starting our unit on measurement.
